

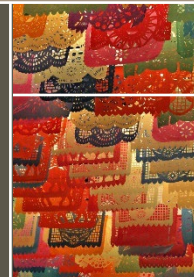

Hello NLPOA members! After the June 2023 newsletter went out last month a few of you brought to my attention that you hadn't received it in your inbox. I suggested that those members check their spam/junk folder. Only two or three members said they did find the newsletter email in their spam/junk folder. This became concerning to me. After looking into this concern, I determined that it appears my emails were BLOCKED by a few email servers for many of our members. The biggest culprit was identified as Gmail. The overwhelming consensus when communicating with the email servers including Gmail was, they deemed the email to be suspicious and its validity unknown so they either sent it to the spam/junk folder, or they overall just blocked the email from getting through all together to protect YOU, their client. This issue seems to only be affecting my "mass" email sending. So, whenever I send emails to all the members of NLPOA at once. Individual emails from me to any member seem to not be affected.
