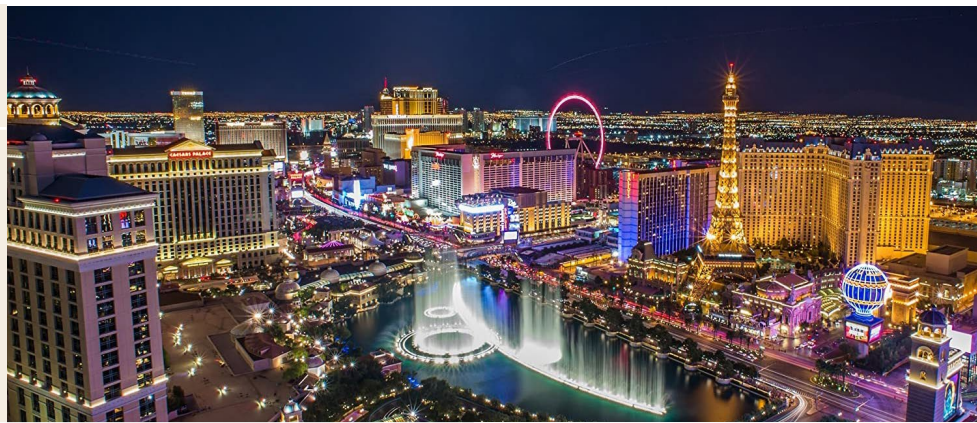

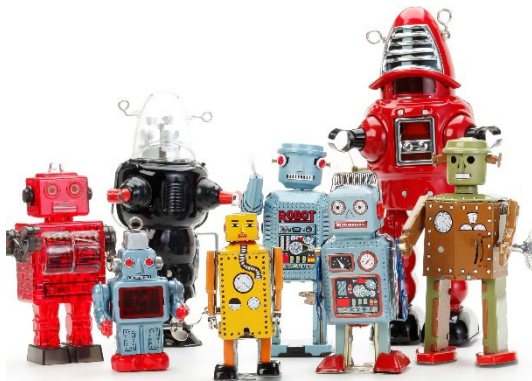


Toy Drive Event & Christmas in el Barrio
